## NURSERY TO REOPEN

We're happy to report that the Peacehaven Native Nursery will reopen to the public on **Thursday 7 May**.

Trading hours will be as before: 9 am to 12.30 pm on Thursdays; 9 am to 1 pm on Saturdays.

There will of course be some safety restrictions relating to COVID-19:

- Strict physical distancing rules will apply.
- No more than four customers permitted in the nursery at any one time.
- Payments to be made by card only – no cash accepted.
- The EFTPOS terminal and counter will be cleaned between transactions.
